**"Hibernating Myocardium:
Identification and Management"**

Objectives

1. To recognize importance of coronary artery disease in epidemiology of heart failure in the U.S.
2. To recognize the relative abilities of echocardiography, myocardial perfusion imaging, positron emission tomography and cardiac magnetic resonance in identifying viable myocardium and functional response to myocardial revascularization
3. To define current divergent guidelines recommendations for imaging for myocardial ischemia and viability in patients with left ventricular dysfunction.
